

INSTALLING INSULATOR IN 40MT SERIES STARTER

- 1. This is the correct insulator for this starter.
- 2. As compared to the old type insulator, it is:
 - A. Different in appearance.
 - B. Shorter in length.
 - C. Made of a superior insulating material.
- 3. When installed:
 - A. The notch should be located under the field coils.
 - B. The field frame terminal should be located between the insulator ends.
 - C. The round holes should be located under the field frame round holes or rectangular holes.
